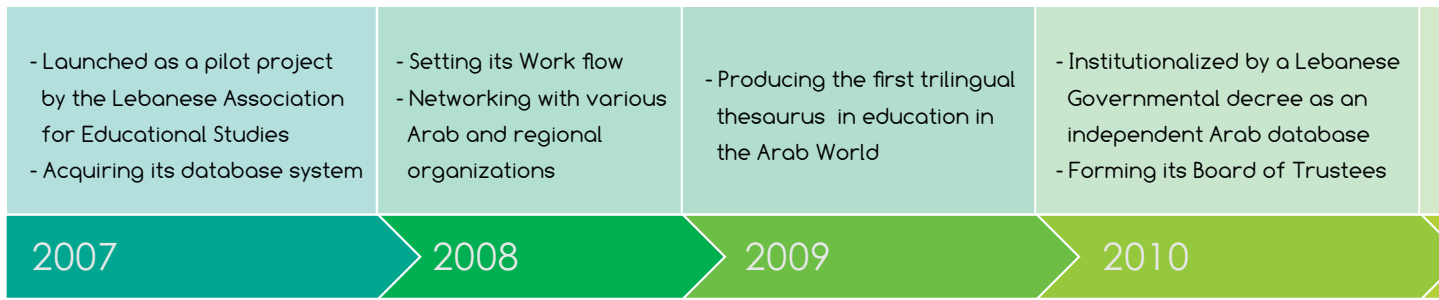


An Educational Database

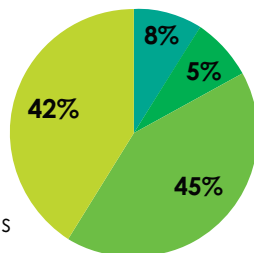
Mission

Shamaa provides specialists and stakeholders free internet access to the educational studies produced in the Arab countries, as well as those available through international organizations with whom Shamaa has signed cooperation agreements.

Shamaa also welcomes submissions by researchers on education in the Arab countries produced worldwide. It indexes peer-refereed articles, Master theses and PhD dissertations, books, reports and conference proceedings dated 2007 onward in Arabic, English and French.

The database includes bibliographic information, abstracts and, when available, full text of educational studies.

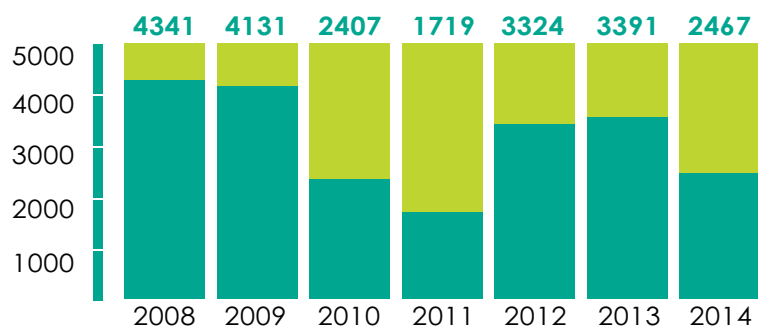
Distribution of Shamaa records by type of publication

Vision

Shamaa aspires to be a main reference for researchers and others concerned with educational knowledge, as a database that documents all sorts of scholarly work on education produced in the Arab countries and by Arab researchers.

Objectives

1. Document all scholarly educational works produced as of 2007 in the Arab countries in Arabic, French, and English, in addition to the studies dealing with education in the Arab countries, though not published in the Arab region, and studies produced by international organizations with whom Shamaa has cooperation agreement.
2. Disseminate information on educational studies and make them available to researchers, faculty members, university students, and all those concerned with educational matters.
3. Facilitate the review of educational research, allowing the accumulation of educational knowledge, promoting innovation, improvement of teaching, learning, and research practices as well as informing decision-making in education.
4. Facilitate networking among researchers, organizations, universities, professional associations, and individuals working in the education fields.
5. Contribute to the clarification of concepts and technical terms used in educational literature, through the production of an educational thesaurus and updating it periodically.
6. Promote the culture of documenting educational literature in the Arab World as well as the use of databases.



Number of documents entered by year



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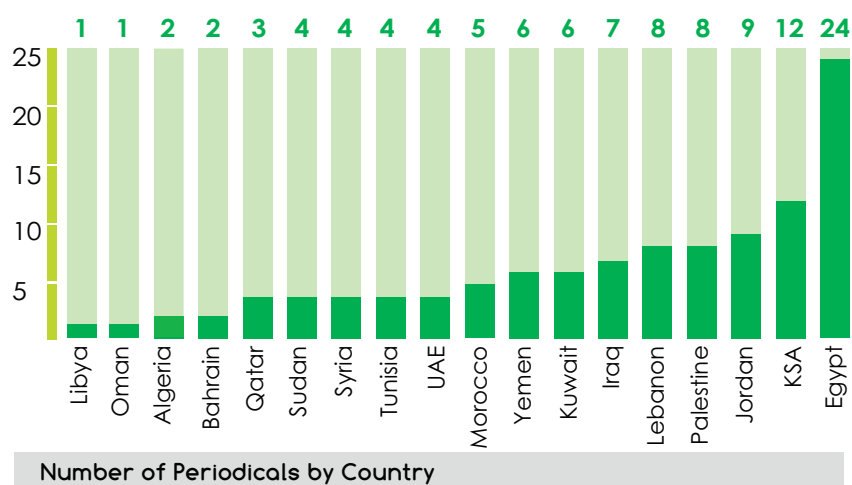
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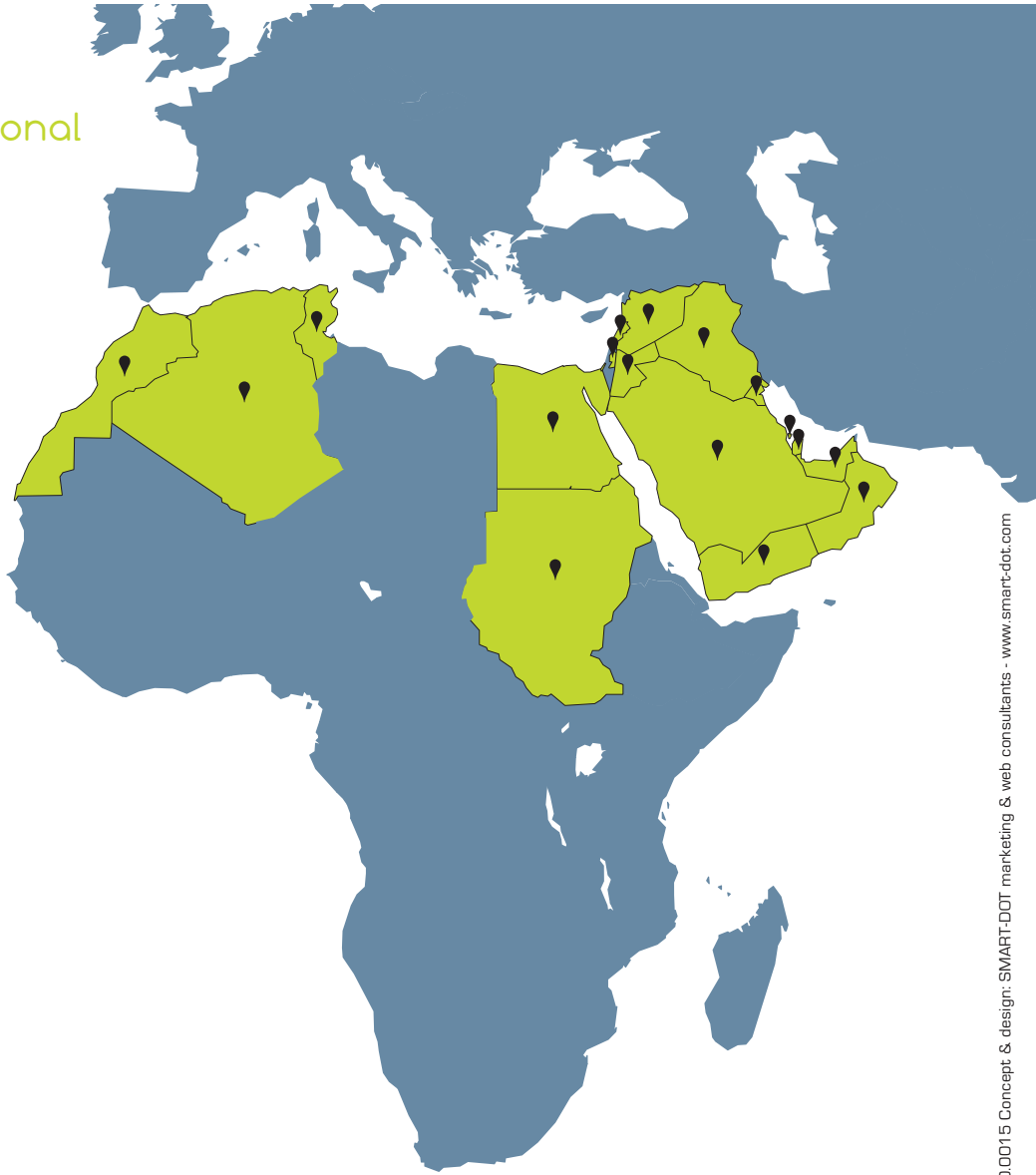
